California Tribal TANF Partnership (CTTP) is a federal & state funded social service agency. We offer services and temporary services to Native American families in Northern & Central CA.

To be eligible for CTTTP programs & services applicants must go through an in-take approval process. Applicants must be a resident within Amador County. Applying does not guarantee approval. Household must have at least one Indian child under the age of 18.
