If you are a survivor, this **FREE** 5-week program will help you regain self-confidence and empower you to manage your own life. Topics include:

- Education and job training
- Coaching on job-readiness and employment seeking skills
- Development of personal financial plans
- Credit reports/credit counseling
- Assistance with budgeting, debt-reduction, saving and investing
- Banking practices and account management
- Many incentives including bus passes and gift cards

Survivors of domestic violence, current or past participants of Operation Care domestic violence programs.
